- Events: The venue hosted 239 events, including BlueScope events and various other functions such as meetings, conferences & exhibitions.
- Upgrades: New digital equipment was installed in the Visitor Centre, funded by the Port Kembla Community Investment Fund. This includes a robust WiFi system, digital banners, and a new venue-wide signage control system, enhancing the venue's appeal and functionality.
- Infrastructure: With BlueScope's assistance, road access to the Visitor Centre and its extensive car parking facilities was improved.
- Guides: The Guide Pool remains stable, with five new guides inducted in 2024. Opportunities are available for those interested in becoming guides, especially those who enjoy introducing people to new sights and have an interest or experience in industry.

- Maintenance: The Visitor Centre remains wellmaintained, with gardening, grass maintenance, general cleaning, gutter-cleaning, and asset management coordinated through BlueScope Properties and other contractors.
- Cybersecurity: With advice from BlueScope IT, cybercrime exposure was assessed, including a Data Risk Review, and various safeguards were implemented.
- STEM Activities: STEM activities continue to expand, ensuring Inside Industry remains relevant to new and cleaner industrial practices at Port Kembla, especially for students and teachers.
- Partnerships: New financial partnership opportunities are being identified and developed to support program expansion. Opportunities exist for new partners to join our programs, providing mutual benefits.
- Website Upgrade: A thorough website upgrade was completed in 2024 to ensure this valuable marketing and communication tool is working to its full potential.
